Kirsten Engel Announces Debate Schedule for General Election Engel has agreed to a televised debate with her opponent on Arizona PBS

TUCSON, AZ — Democratic Candidate for Arizona's 6th Congressional District, Kirsten Engel, announced her campaign's debate schedule for the general election. She has accepted the invitation from Arizona PBS to debate her opponent on August 27th. This event has traditionally been the key debate in this region of Arizona.

"I look forward to having an honest and frank discussion with my opponent about the issues I am hearing from voters all across this district," **said Kirsten Engel.** "Since being elected to office, Juan Ciscomani has done nothing but put the needs of Washington special interests and MAGA extremists over the needs of Arizonans. We are sick and tired of the dysfunction, and southern Arizona deserves better representation than Juan Ciscomani."

Engel faces Ciscomani in a rematch from 2022, where she lost by approximately 5,000 votes despite being outspent 6 to 1. Last cycle, Ciscomani <u>refused to debate</u> Engel on television, and this year, Ciscomani <u>refused to debate</u> his primary opponent, who was able to garner more than 40% of the vote.
