New Ad: Kirsten Engel's New GOTV Ad Features Gabby Giffords

Giffords and Engel urge Arizonans to Vote in New Ad

TUCSON, AZ — **Democratic Candidate for Arizona's 6th Congressional District, Kirsten Engel's <u>eleventh ad</u>** of the cycle, titled "Together," features former Tucson-area Congresswoman Gabby Giffords urging Arizonans to vote. The new ad is part of Engel's get out the vote efforts in the final two weeks of the campaign. It highlights some of the key issues at stake this November, including addressing high costs and reproductive freedom.

The national gun violence prevention organization <u>GIFFORDS</u>, founded by Gabby Giffords, is already supporting Engel. Earlier this month, the PAC announced an over \$1.2 million investment in the race.

"With just 12 days left until Election Day, it's critical that every eligible Arizonan gets out and votes," said **Engel**. "We know this election will be close and every vote will matter.

With our district and our country facing pressing issues, we can't afford another term of Juan Ciscomani's inaction on high costs, reproductive rights, and border security. In Congress, I'll always put the best interests of Arizonans first. Go vote today!"

"So much is at stake in this election, from the freedom to choose what we do with our bodies, to the freedom to live without fear of gun violence," **said Giffords.** "Kirsten Engel is the only candidate in this race who is committed to protecting our freedoms and fighting for a safer future. As the former representative of this district, I know Kirsten is the best person to represent Tucson in Congress. It's time for us to get out the vote and vote for Kirsten!"

The campaign has reserved nearly \$5 million in broadcast and digital communications between now and Election Day, and is running Spanish-language communications on broadcast, digital, and radio.

Engel faces Ciscomani in a rematch from 2022, where she lost by approximately 5,000 votes despite being outspent 6 to 1. She is committed to putting Arizona families over Washington special interests – that's why she has rejected corporate PAC money, and is proud to have received more than 78,000 individual donations this campaign cycle. Her average contribution is \$76. She has also secured key endorsements locally and nationally, including from Senator Mark Kelly, End Citizens United, Planned Parenthood, and AFSCME.
