New Ads: New Engel TV Ads Highlight Ciscomani Choosing Politics over People

New ads call out Ciscomani for voting against the interests of Arizonans on Social

Security and the border

TUCSON, AZ — Today, **Democratic Candidate for Arizona's 6th Congressional District, Kirsten Engel**, released her campaign's <u>sixth</u> and <u>seventh</u> ads of the cycle, titled "Be There" and "Games." Focusing on Juan Ciscomani's votes against the interest of seniors and opposition to the bipartisan border deal respectively, the ads show just how far out of step the extremist Republican is with Arizona voters.

"Time and time again, Ciscomani has voted against the interests of Arizonans," **said Engel**. "He's had his chance to deliver solutions and support our community, but instead, he's chosen to follow his MAGA party bosses rather than protect and deliver for people of his own district. From his votes that would make life more difficult for seniors to his opposition to the bipartisan immigration bill that would have increased border security and limited the flow of fentanyl, his record after two years is abysmal. He can't be trusted to stand up for our seniors, he can't be trusted to address our most pressing issues, and he can't be trusted to continue representing Arizona's Sixth District in Congress."

Juan Ciscomani's record of failing to stand up for seniors:

- Voted to cut access to Social Security
- Supports a budget that would <u>raise the retirement age</u> for Social Security and <u>increase the cost of prescription drugs</u> for seniors on Medicare
- Joined an extreme Washington group working to repeal Medicare's ability to negotiate for lower drug prices and end the \$35 insulin cap for seniors on Medicare

The bipartisan border deal Ciscomani opposed was endorsed by the Border Patrol Union and <u>included</u> funding for:

- Hiring more Customs and Border Protection agents
- Installing cutting edge drug detection machines at our ports of entry to stop the flow of fentanyl into Arizona
- Additional immigration judges and thousands more Asylum Officers

Background

The campaign has reserved over \$4 million in broadcast and digital communications between now and Election Day, and is running Spanish-language communications on broadcast, digital, and radio.

Engel faces Ciscomani in a rematch from 2022, where she lost by approximately 5,000 votes despite being outspent 6 to 1. She is committed to putting Arizona families over Washington special interests – that's why she has rejected corporate PAC contributions to her campaign, and is proud to have received more than 78,000 individual donations this campaign cycle. Her average contribution is \$85. She has also secured key endorsements locally and nationally, including from Senator Mark Kelly, End Citizens United, Planned Parenthood, and AFSCME.

Kirsten Engel is a mom, an environmental attorney, and a former State Legislator who has fought for years to restore funding to public schools, protect Arizona's natural resources, and make our communities safer. She's ready to take that fight to Washington to find common-sense solutions to the challenges we're facing here in Arizona's Sixth Congressional District.
