Engel Campaign Releases New Ad with Damning Information About Opponent
Ciscomani tied to extreme Christian Nationalist group aiming to rewrite the Constitution

TUCSON, AZ — Kirsten Engel’s campaign released [an ad](#) today with damning information about their opponent, Juan Ciscomani, and his long history with a group called Patriot Academy, a Christian nationalists organization that believes the United States Constitution must be rewritten to avoid “Godless communism,” and trains children as young as 11 years in the use of lethal force to defend a Christian nation.

“Arizonans are finally learning the truth about Juan Ciscomani and his extremist roots,” **stated Alia Kapasi, spokesperson from the campaign.** “His record is clear – he brought the Patriot Academy to Arizona, and he has voted with the MAGA right-wing crowd time and time again during his short time in office. Ciscomani himself admits that his fourteen years on the board of this radical organization has given his life direction -- explaining his repeated votes siding with MAGA extremists and restricting abortion rights. Arizonans deserve better than Juan Ciscomani and they’re going to make that clear at the ballot box this November.”

For fourteen years, Juan Ciscomani has been on the board of The Patriot Academy and says that “nothing in life has given him a clearer direction”. The Patriot Academy:

- Believes we should rewrite the constitution, establishing a Christian Nation
- Believes the separation of Church and State is a myth
- Is against all abortion and would abolish gay marriage
- Trains children as young as eleven to be “combat focused” and in the most effective way to kill
