Kirsten Engel Raises More than Double Ciscomani in Q3 Engel raised nearly \$3 million to Ciscomani's \$1.4 million

TUCSON, AZ — Last week, **Democratic Candidate for Arizona's 6th Congressional District, Kirsten Engel** announced that she raised nearly \$3 million in Q3, setting a new record for the most raised by a campaign in the 6th District's history. This week, it was revealed that she more than doubled her extremist opponent, Juan Ciscomani, who raised just \$1.4 million. Ciscomani's numbers are inflated by corporate PAC donations, including from the oil and gas, mining, tobacco, and private prison industries. Just 48% of Ciscomani's donations came from individual donors, in stark contrast with 80% of Engel's.

"These recent fundraising numbers reflect a broader trend in this race – our campaign is about the people of AZ-06, while Ciscomani continues to cater to special interests," said **Engel's Campaign Manager, Alia Kapasi**. "His out of touch views and votes on abortion, the border, and raising costs would be devastating to Arizonans. Meanwhile, our people-powered campaign is connecting with voters and working to represent their best interests in Washington. We hear their message loud and clear – it's time for a change."

The campaign has reserved over \$4 million in broadcast and digital communications between now and Election Day, and is running Spanish-language communications on broadcast, digital, and radio.

Engel faces Ciscomani in a rematch from 2022, where she lost by approximately 5,000 votes despite being outspent 6 to 1. She is committed to putting Arizona families over Washington special interests – that's why she has rejected corporate PAC money, and is proud to have received more than 78,000 individual donations this campaign cycle. Her average contribution is \$76. She has also secured key endorsements locally and nationally, including from Senator Mark Kelly, End Citizens United, Planned Parenthood, and AFSCME.

Kirsten Engel is a mom, an environmental attorney, and a former State Legislator who has fought for years to restore funding to public schools, protect Arizona's natural resources, and make our communities safer. She's ready to take that fight to Washington to find common-sense solutions to the challenges we're facing here in Arizona's Sixth Congressional District.
