



ICYMI: Kirsten Engel Slams Ciscomani Over Anti-Abortion Record

"I don't trust you with my health care, I don't trust you with my daughter's health care."



TUCSON, AZ — On Tuesday, **Democratic Candidate for Arizona's 6th Congressional District, Kirsten Engel** had her second and final debate with her extremist anti-abortion opponent, Juan Ciscomani. During the debate, Engel shared a powerful message defending the right for women to make their own health care decisions:

"I'm a woman. I've had complications. I've had miscarriages. This is not something we leave to politicians. Last time I checked Juan – you're not a doctor. I don't trust you with my health care. I'm sorry I don't trust you with my daughter's health care. We need to leave this to women and their doctors, it's too important.

Women are dying as a result of this lack of health care. It's not something we put in a lens of this week or that week – we leave this to the woman and her doctor."

Ciscomani couldn't defend his anti-abortion record or his <u>longstanding ties with the</u> <u>extreme right-wing organization, the Patriot Academy</u>. The Patriot Academy rejects the separation of church and state, seeks to rewrite the Constitution to establish a Christian Nation, and supports a national abortion ban with no exceptions. Despite his attempts to convince voters he is a "moderate," Engel made it clear to voters at the debate that his record says otherwise.

Juan Ciscomani's Anti-Abortion Record:

- As part of the Doug Ducey Administration, Ciscomani <u>vetted and helped pack the</u>
 <u>State Supreme Court</u> with the judges who voted in favor of the archaic 1864
 abortion ban.
- Immediately upon getting to Washington, he joined the Republican Study
 Committee which is working to pass the <u>Life At Conception Act</u> which is a
 national abortion ban with no exception for rape, incest, or the life of the mother.
- As part of the House Appropriations Committee, Ciscomani voted in Congress for a clean stand alone amendment to <u>restrict access to medication abortion</u> nationwide.
- Ciscomani also voted to <u>restrict reproductive care for active duty service</u> <u>members</u>.
